OXFORD BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' AGENDA SESSION
OXFORD CITY HALL – COMMISSIONERS' BOARD ROOM

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Oxford met at the above-mentioned time and place to set the agenda for the Regular Meeting to be held August 17, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, 300 Williamsboro Street. All members of the Board and local news media were notified of the same as well as the purpose of the meeting.

Mayor Pro Tem Herring called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC HEARING – TAXICAB SERVICE AS REQUESTED BY GEORGE CANFIELD

Mayor Pro Tem Herring declared the public hearing open. No one from the audience wished to speak; there were no questions from the Board. MPT Herring declared the public hearing closed. MPT Herring reminded the Board that it approved this service at its July 13th regular meeting.

AGENDA SET

City Engineer Larry Thomas stated this is considered an illicit discharge under the Stormwater Policy. It was agreed that this matter would go to the Public Works Committee.
