**AGENDA SET – SEPTEMBER 12, 2006**

The Board of Commissioners set the agenda for the September 12, 2006 meeting.

**GRANVILLE BUSINESS PARK SEWER LINE**

Randy McNeill of Davis, Martin & Powell explained Millridge had contracted with DMP to route the sewer line for Granville Business Park. He presented a map of the proposed route of the sewer line.

Commissioner Kiesow asked who would pay for the line? Mr. McNeill noted Millridge is working with the County, the hub group and working to acquire grants. City Engineer Thomas

explained Millridge will ask the City to take over the line and construction should begin within the next 6 months.

### **STOVALL WATER LINE UPDATE**

Randy McNeill noted the contractor installing the water line to Stovall is moving quickly, 1000 ft per day. He noted they have run into rock, which has slowed the progress. He stated the County has committed to 10 hydrants to put on this end and noted a 300 gpm pump would have to be put in, instead of the 100 gpm. He stated the County would be paying for this.
