**OXFORD CITY HALL, BOARD MEETING ROOM,
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2007 AT 5:45 PM**

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Oxford met for an Agenda Session at City Hall, 300 Williamsboro Street at the above-mentioned time and place.

All members of the board and local news media were notified of the time, place and purpose of the meeting.

Mayor Woodlief called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS BY MAYOR WOODLIEF

Mayor Woodlief explained Granville County Board of Elections had sent a contract for signature requesting use of the Training Room at no charge for all upcoming elections. He added he was under the impression it was only for the 2008 Presidential Election. He stressed City Hall cannot accommodate 8,500 people. Public Works cannot be used for 3 ½ weeks because the locks would have to be changed and could not be used for rentals. Commissioner Herring suggested renting the assembly room at Public Works to the Board of Elections; Mayor Woodlief added they are not willing to pay.

Mayor Woodlief added Dorothy Pruitt, Hubert Gooch, L.C. Adcock, Eve Harris and Lucy Hobgood went to Wilson and acquired items (desks, blackboard, etc.) from an old school to furnish the classroom on the 3rd Floor of City Hall.

The Board of Commissioners set the agenda for the February 13, 2007 meeting.

CLOSED SESSION – CONTRACT

On a motion by Commissioner Shope, seconded by Commissioner Kiesow, the Board voted to go into Closed Session according to G.S. 143-318.11 to discuss a contract. The motion passed unanimously.

At the end of the closed session and on motion by Commissioner Wilkinson, seconded by Commissioner Williford, the Board voted unanimously to return to the open session.
