**AGENDA SET**

The Board set the agenda for the July 14<sup>th</sup> regular session.

**ADDITIONS**

Mayor Pro Tem Herring asked City Manager Donham what progress has been made on the nuisance law. This issue has been on the table for several years, and MPT Herring expressed his wishes to see it put to rest.

CM Donham explained that he has spoken with Chief John Wolford and that he will meet with the Chief and Tom Burnette to work on details of this law. CM Donham stated that this law will probably bring suit against the City, but it may be necessary to preserve property values.

CM Donham explained that as for the criminal nuisance law, this is being looked into and that he will try to have a report for Tuesday night's regular meeting.

CM Donham was asked the status of the report on public safety. He stated that there has been a delay but that he anticipated the report to be completed this week.

It was requested that the Public Works Committee meet on Friday, July 10<sup>th</sup> to discuss the valve at the WWTP lagoon which will not open. City Engineer Larry Thomas distributed a quote from H.G. Reynolds on the work necessary to correct the problem. (*Note: quote will be a part of the meeting package.*)
