**OXFORD BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' SPECIAL MEETING
TO CONSIDER REHABILITATION BIDS**

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Oxford met at the above-mentioned time and place for a special meeting at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall, 300 Williamsboro Street. All members of the Board and local news media were notified of the same as well as the purpose of the meeting.

Present were: Mayor Al Woodlief, Jr., Mayor Pro Tem Howard Herring, Sr., Commissioners Robert B. Williford, Sr., Danny Currin, Ron Bullock, and Walter Cantley.

Present also were City Manager Mark Donham and City Clerk Donna B. Hosch.

Absent were: Commissioners Jackie Sergent (out of town), Calvin Harris, Jr., and City Attorney J. Thomas Burnette.

SEWER REHABILITATION BIDS APPROVED

Mayor Pro Tem Herring called the meeting to order. He stated that the staff recommended the following: awarding the bid to the low bidder, TA Loving, in the amount of \$784,600 and carrying forward to fiscal year 2011 the Rural Center Project (932-926) at a reduced cost of \$550,000 and carrying forward Water Capital Project #1 (937-926) at a reduced cost of \$350,000.

COMMISSIONER CANTLEY MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BIDS AS PRESENTED.

Commissioner Cantley stated the Public Works Committee met and recommended approving the bids and that the funds are coming out of the Water Fund.
