CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Sergent called the meeting to order.

MATCHING FUNDS FOR FY 2016 CMAQ GRANT AUTHORIZED
PROJECT: END OF GRANVILLE CORNERS TO COVENTRY DRIVE

Mayor Sergent presented a request to consider authorizing staff to apply for a Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) grant and commit to matching funds in the amount of \$60,000.

It was recently announced that CMAQ funds are available for FY2016. The City will apply for a grant totaling \$300,000. The City’s match would be \$60,000. If awarded, the CMAQ funds, the project will be a continuation of the current sidewalk project and begin at the 2nd Shopping Center entrance on Industry Dr. ending at Coventry Dr. The deadline for the application is June 7, 2015. Planning Director Hart will ask the Oxford Housing Authority if they would contribute to the cost of the sidewalk because it will run in front of Juniper Court. Because they are new construction, Jake’s Ridge Apartments and the proposed Thornrose Apartments will be required to lay sidewalks.

COMMISSIONER WILLIFORD MADE A MOTION TO AUTHORIZE STAFF TO APPLY FOR A CMAQ GRANT (FY 2016) AND COMMIT TO MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT \$60,000. ALL VOTES WERE IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. **THE MOTION CARRIED.**
